My name is David Lewis and I am the Regional Director for Daylight in South Wales and the South West.

My work inside Prison is mainly centred on running the prison edition of Christianity Explored (CE). I run this course each week in HMP Cardiff with Gillian Pegler. This is always a blessed time as we teach the prisoners from the Word of God about who Jesus is, why He came into the world and ultimately what this means for us all. We have seen great fruit from this over the past few years as the Lord has blessed us.

The Discipleship Explored course has just started running in HMP Ashfield. We ran a CE course before Christmas and we now have a dozen men deepening their knowledge of our Saviour from the book of Philipians. I have started this course off and am hoping to 'hand over' to one of my colleagues and a member of a local church.

One of my tasks, and delights, is to promote the work of Daylight in churches amongst God's people. This is always an encouraging evening for everyone as we hear about what God is doing amongst prisoners. I also run the Prayer and Support Group in Swansea. We meet each month to pray for the work and to see how we can practically support Prisoners and their families as they are released.

HMP Eastwood Park – Give thanks that the CE course has gone really well. About 10 women have completed the course, and we are planning the next one!

Dorking PSG – Give thanks that they have had several inquiries from people who are interested in becoming prison visitors. Please pray for the right people, who understand Daylight's vision, who are able to commit time, and are willing to support the work of the prison chaplains.

Please pray for their next prison service on April 9th; for open hearts to receive the Word of God, that the attendees would be blessed and drawn closer to God.

Please pray for the volunteers and those who write letters, that they would remain non-judgemental, compassionate and wise in all their dealings with inmates.

Bible Studies – Please pray that we might be able to resume mid-week Bible studies at a prison where regime changes have caused them to stop.

Christianity Explored – Please pray for a CE course which is due to begin soon at a prison where we have not been able to go before.

Lance – Please continue to pray for Lance, an 18 year old whose disruptive attitude has been completely reversed. He shows very encouraging signs of being saved. He is due to be moved to an adult prison soon. Pray that God will enable him to continue in his new found faith when he gets to his new surroundings.
