Christianity Explored - Give thanks for Christianity Explored Prison Edition courses that are currently being run in HMPs Ashfield, Bristol and Swansea. Please pray for David, Jane, Jon, Lindsay, Paul and Stephen who are running these courses and for the prisoners who come along to them.

HMP Maidstone - A prisoner at the weekly Daylight Bible study recently said, "I'm so thankful I've come to prison. I've learnt so much from these Bible studies." He then asked his fellow prisoners "What do you guys think?" and they all agreed. Please pray for each of the men who attend this Bible study, that what they are learning would have a lasting influence on their lives.

George & Jackie Gibson - Please pray for George and Jackie as they go to meet a chaplain at a prison in the North West at the beginning of this month, with a view to establishing a Daylight presence in that prison.

Keith - Some of you have met Keith, and many of you have been praying for him. He became a Christian 25 years ago during his first year in prison and was released on licence about a year ago. We were concerned when we lost contact with him a few weeks ago. We now know he has been recalled to prison. Please pray for him.
