HMP Bristol – Pray for a local church leader, Steve who will be speaking and leading at the service on the 15th February for the first time and for the musicians going in with him.

HMP Cardiff – Please pray for T, a traveller who has professed faith. It will be difficult to walk with the Lord in the traveller community. Please pray that he would know grace and sustaining mercy.

HMP Erlestone – Pray for Daylight volunteers from Corsham Baptist Church leading a service on the 1st March in preparation for their first Christianity Explored/Discipleship Explored course after Easter.

HMP Portland – Monday evenings seem to have settled into the programme, with up to 6 men coming for studies in Mark’s Gospel. Please pray that those who have signed up will be willing to come and that staff will be able to get them to the Chapel.

HMP Usk - We have now finished our Bible studies into the letter to the Ephesians. Please pray for wisdom as we look to try and grow the group.

Bury St Edmunds PSG – The Lord has been gracious to them in developing a solid relationship with the chaplain at a local prison and because of this they now attend the worship service within the prison twice a month which we give thanks for. They have also been given opportunities to pray one on one with certain prisoners which has been a great blessing to them. Their biggest prayer need at the moment is that the Lord will provide a musician to help the group. Although they contribute to the worship service each time they attend they need a musician so they can take the whole service themselves. Please pray for this and for the continued work of the Lord at this prison.

Dorking PSG – Please pray for their next prison service on 8th February that hearts would be open to the message, and ready to receive the life-giving Word of God. Please pray for those who will be ministering, for a clear message, for grace and love in speaking and praying for those who attend; for protection from harm on the roads and in the prison.

Please pray for peace for those inmates who are anxious and worried about many things, that their hope and faith will give them strength to endure.

Bible Studies - Give thanks for changes at HMP Stafford which mean that we can start running a Science & Faith course on the 9th February and for the opportunity to resume Bible studies at HMP Birmingham shortly.

Pray for the regular Bible studies at HMP Oakwood and for the Science & Faith course to be run at HMP Featherstone after Easter followed by Christianity Explored later in the year.

Keith – We have heard from Keith again recently. Since his recall he has been unable to have any visitors and he is struggling with some very dark thoughts. Please pray for him.

L – Please pray for him as he has recently been sentenced. He seems to have become a Christian whilst on remand and is showing a real Christian attitude in response to his extremely difficult circumstances.

Prison Ministry Associate - Building up converted prisoners is an important part of Daylight's ministry. One of our Prison Ministry Associates is running a Bible study series on Biblical Praying, taking 12 Old and New Testament prayers as models.

He was greatly encouraged after one such study that the prayers were significantly more Biblically 'flavoured' than had been the case in the past.

Please pray that believers might not only grow in understanding but in a deepening of their devotional life.

Russell – Please pray for Russell who came to the Sunday service after some sort of vision during the night. It turned out that he had a background in another faith but found the message highly relevant to his life. He said he had been watching the lives of Christians on his wing and realised he was missing something. He has now been released, so please pray the Lord will continue to work in his life and bring him into further contact with Christians.
