## Daylight Prayer Points May 2015

**HMP Birmingham** – Please pray for the work here which will involve taking Christianity Explored (CE) to different wings on a rota.

**HMP Cardiff** – Please pray for the current CE course which has a few weeks left to run and also the week long CE course that will be running at the end of May.

**HMP Featherstone** – We start an eight week Science & Faith course here soon with great anticipation by the chaplains and the prisoners.

**HMP Gartree** – Give thanks that we have been asked to provide more dates here following changes to the staff.

**HMP Oakwood** – Give thanks for encouragement here. The chaplains are now encouraging more men to attend the Bible studies. One prisoner has been attending for years, but is still unsaved. Pray that the light might dawn on his soul and that he might put his trust in Christ.

**HMP Portland** – Pray that much fruit would come from the regular Bible studies in Mark's Gospel.

**HMP Sudbury** – Give thanks that the work here is going well with services on the evening of the third and fifth Sundays of the month as well as weekly Tuesday evening Bible studies.

**HMP Swansea** – Please pray that David would be able to start as a sessional chaplain in the prison.

**HMP Usk** – Please pray for the weekly Bible studies that more of the prisoners would regularly attend.

**Chelmsford PSG** – Give thanks for a good service in a local prison in April. Please pray that the prisoners that came would remember the message they heard and that it would touch their hearts.

**Dorking PSG** – Give thanks for continued open doors at their local prisons. Please pray for their next visit to a local prison in May; for health and protection for those taking the service, and for open hearts for those who attend, and for those who are seeking God that they may find Him.

Also, pray that God would call more people from the Dorking area that will pray and support the work of Daylight in their local prisons.

**Norwich PSG** – Preaching opportunities continue every six weeks or so. There is enthusiasm amongst a number of the men, with some having recently been baptised or confirmed. Please pray that this enthusiasm will not lack a true understanding of the Gospel, and pray for continued help in the preaching.

**Daniel** – He has a granddaughter with cerebal palsy and wants to raise funds for her to have an operation in the USA but he is unable to do anything whilst he is in prison. He is a regular attendee at the mid week Bible study and seems close to becoming a Christian.

**Harry** – Please continue to pray for Harry who has become a Christian during his long sentence. He has been diagnosed with aggressive throat cancer. He is being kept spiritually in amazing peace despite the side effects of his radiotherapy.

**James** – James who is coming to the end of a long sentence is in his 80's and unwell. He is in great discomfort but still makes the effort to come to the Bible study.

**L** – He is responding well to his disappointment and is treating his long sentence as an opportunity to learn more about his Saviour. He is however being goaded by some fellow prisoners and struggles to deal with this as a Christian should. Please pray that this might stop and that he may remain in the wing where he is less likely to be tempted.

**Letter Writing** – Please pray for the letter writing work that goes on all the time managed by one of our volunteers. One of our staff recently heard how excited a couple were that they had both been given new prisoners to write to.

**Michael** - Pray for those who have been converted in prison. One prisoner, Michael asked for prayer that he would know how to serve the Lord inside and how to tell others.

**Nigel Robinson** – Give thanks for the many opportunities that are opening up. Nigel is in various prisons most days and sometimes in two different prisons in a day.

**Patrick** – Please pray that as recently released Patrick is exposed to authentic Christianity through Graham's opening up of the Word of God, his heart and life will be transformed. (Graham is a Daylight volunteer from a local church, who is meeting regularly with Patrick.)

**Richard (ex-offender)** – Please pray for him. He is facing great uncertainty and needs to be upheld.

**Scotland** – Please remember M who has shown an interest in spiritual things. He is being bullied by fellow inmates and this has led to him self-harming.

J has been interested in the Gospel message in the past but now says he does not feel comfortable attending chapel because he is distracted by those who attend and are not interested.

Another chaplain is soon to be appointed for a local prison known to us. Please pray that the right person would be chosen and that he would be used by God in that important and influential role. Please also pray that more Prayer & Support Groups would be formed in various areas in Scotland.

One of our volunteers occasionally visits another prison in Scotland and reports that meetings there have proved a blessing to S in the past and he is faithfully reading the Scriptures and other good books as a result of attending these meetings. Please remember him and H, a fellow inmate who never has any visitors but responds well to the Gospel message.
