Over recent months, prisoners at one of our Bible study groups have been inviting along others who have some interest in Christianity and religion. The sessions have been spent explaining the Gospel and answering questions they have. New Testaments have been given to some of these prisoners and they have been returning each week asking more questions from what they have read.

At a recent session they were asking questions about the cross and one young man left at the end wiping away his tears, while another said, "I can see it now!". Please pray that the Lord will work in their lives and bring them to salvation.

A few months ago at one of our services in another prison, one of our volunteers spoke to a prisoner who said he was an atheist. At the end of their conversation, the prisoner said, "You've really made me think".

When our volunteer saw this prisoner again at the end of February, he said that he had continued to think about things, had been attending the services and had now been saved. Please pray that this profession will prove to be genuine, that he will grow in grace and that he will be a witness to staff and other prisoners.

In Scotland, two young men who have been attending the Christianity Explored course recently requested baptism and have now been baptised. Please pray that they would be enabled to live a consistent Christian life and be a blessing to others.
