Give thanks that since restrictions fully lifted more prisoners have been able to attend Sunday Services each week. As well as opening up God's Word with them, these services provide good opportunities to speak to and pray with individual prisoners. Prison staff are present too, and sometimes comment on what they have heard, with one saying, "Thank you...I really mean that. You've given me something to think about".

Please pray that the messages preached will be used to speak to both prisoners and prison staff.

Monday 10th

Please pray for prisoners who are working through Emmaus Bible School Courses and reading other Christian literature in their cells, that these resources will help them to learn more about God's Word and that the Holy Spirit will apply these truths to their hearts.

Tuesday 11th



Give thanks that our regular written messages continue to reach a good number of prisoners. Many have let us know how much they appreciate these, with one writing, "It is such a blessing that I receive this encouragement & support"?

Please pray that these messages will continue to be an encouragement to Christian prisoners and that others will be challenged by what they read.

Wednesday 12th

We are thankful for the ongoing opportunities that chaplaincy work provides to offer support to individual prisoners on the wings.



Give thanks for ex-offenders who have settled into local churches. Please pray that they will receive the support they need and will be kept on the right path.

Pray too for others who will be leaving prison in the coming months, that suitable churches will be found for them, and that they will be helped as they face the practical concerns of finding employment and accommodation.
